## EARLY CHILDHOOD CENTERS AND HOME CAREGIVERS



may receive reimbursement when serving an infant **BREAST MILK** 

#### REIMBURSEMENT OF BREAST MILK IS AVAILABLE WHEN:

#### A PARENT BREASTFEEDS AT YOUR CHILD CARE SITE



Providers may receive reimbursement for meals when a breastfeeding parent comes to the child care center or home and directly breastfeeds.

#### A PARENT PROVIDES EXPRESSED OR PUMPED BREAST MILK



Reimbursement is available if a baby **zero to 6 months** of age is **only** fed breast milk for all meals. For babies **6-12 months** reimbursement is available when breastmilk is given along with solids, when babies show signs they are ready for solids.



### EVEN FOR CHILDREN AGE ONE YEAR AND OLDER, REIMBURSEMENT IS AVAILABLE

Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) providers may still receive reimbursement for meals and snacks when a child receives breast milk after one year of age. A written request from the parent is not required.
