Accountabilities:

- Supporting and evaluating the Executive Director by: Ensuring commitment to addressing systemic inequities in breastfeeding outcomes; Developing strategic plan; and Contributing to annual Executive Director performance evaluation
- Ensuring adequate financial resources by: Approving annual budget, audit reports, and material business decisions; Meeting legal and fiduciary responsibilities; and Fundraising and supporting fund-development activities
- Enhancing MIBFN's public standing by: Acting as an MIBFN Ambassador with other organizations and stakeholders; Serving on ad-hoc committees or task forces; Participating in special assignments; and Building and sustaining a competent board

Term of Service, Participation, & Compensation: Participation in meetings is expected. Meetings are conducted as a webinar or conference call, face-to-face meetings occur as needed. Most board members contribute approximately 5 hours per month of direct service to MIBFN. Service on MIBFN's Board of Directors is without remuneration, except for travel and accommodation costs in relation to Board Members' duties
