

DID YOU KNOW? EARLY CHILDHOOD CENTERS AND HOME CAREGIVERS

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may receive reimbursement when serving an infant **BREAST MILK**

REIMBURSEMENT OF BREAST MILK IS AVAILABLE WHEN:

A PARENT BREASTFEEDS AT YOUR CHILD CARE SITE



Providers may receive reimbursement for meals when a breastfeeding parent comes to the child care center or home and directly breastfeeds.

A PARENT PROVIDES EXPRESSED OR PUMPED BREAST MILK



Reimbursement is available if a baby **zero to 6 months** of age is **only** fed breast milk for all meals. For babies **6-12 months** reimbursement is available when breastmilk is given along with solids, when babies show signs they are ready for solids.

EVEN FOR CHILDREN AGE ONE YEAR AND OLDER, REIMBURSEMENT IS AVAILABLE



Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) providers may still receive reimbursement for meals and snacks when a child receives breast milk after one year of age. A written request from the parent is not required.
