1 birth and breastfeeding supporters reflecting and representing families they serve.

- providing timely, skilled, collaborative, **culturally-appropriate lactation care**.
- leveraging **hospital system staff to support breastfeeding** (CNAs, etc).
- **WIC breastfeeding basics reflecting communities** where the training takes place + **community referrals** for breastfeeding support afterwards.



2 dismantling white supremacy, capitalism, and patriarchy as the drivers of the health care and public health systems.

- **insurance companies equitably reimbursing** all skilled lactation providers.
- **trusting Black and Indigenous-led organizations** who provide community-driven solutions for families by institutions.
- shifting towards **community-centered lactation systems** that focus on collaboration and growth.
