NOT PARTNERS YET

Independent of MIBFN but interested in our work and the work of other orgs around the state; ready to share what they are working on and learn about efforts elsewhere

PLANNING

New idea/group, grassroots, leadership embedded in community and ready to make change

REIMAGINING

Established group, ready to serve in new ways (e.g. with geographic coalitions - In identifying with who their community reflects and shifting leadership to ensure it is culturally representative of the organization)

DOING

Purpose and niche are solidified, people are energized, brand is growing, energy is high

STEADY GROWTH

Brand is known, organization is trusted, funders are supporting, work is growing

SUSTAINING, MUTUALLY INTERDEPENDENT PARTNERSHIP

Organization is independent of MIBFN, and work is continuing to move forward

NETWORKING

Sharing new ideas, connecting with other partners, concrete "asks" (e.g. call this legislator, share this with your coalition, let us know X, etc.); and we are amplifying current efforts

INCUBATING

NETWORKING & Convening "new and existing" vision sessions, getting their vision on paper, "supporting" and coaching them in community organizing/relationship building, and budgeting; determining what a more formal partnership might look like and doing some initial fundraising

TAKING ACTION

NETWORKING, INCUBATING & Funds have been raised, contract is established, deliverables are ongoing, and we are making the case for support of full funding

OUTCOMES

NETWORKING & repeating incubating and taking action as requested by organization
