Baby-Friendly evidenced-based practices benefit...



MOTHERS & BABIES

Optimizes maternal-infant bonding for all, regardless of feeding choice

Improves breastfeeding initiation, exclusivity and continuation

Breastfeeding decreases SIDS, ear infections and pneumonia in infants

Breastfeeding decreases breast and ovarian cancer in mothers



DOCTORS & NURSES

Allows for coordination and synergy of evidence-based practices

Decreases breastfeeding problems and complications

Increases maternal involvement and confidence in infant care

Provides framework for education on safety, nutrition, and parenting



HOSPITALS

Improves breastfeeding exclusivity—A Joint Commission standard

Demonstrates commitment to quality improvement

Provides marketing and recruiting advantage

Supports the mission, vision and values of the hospital



COMMUNITIES

Addresses health disparities by improving breastfeeding rates for everyone
