

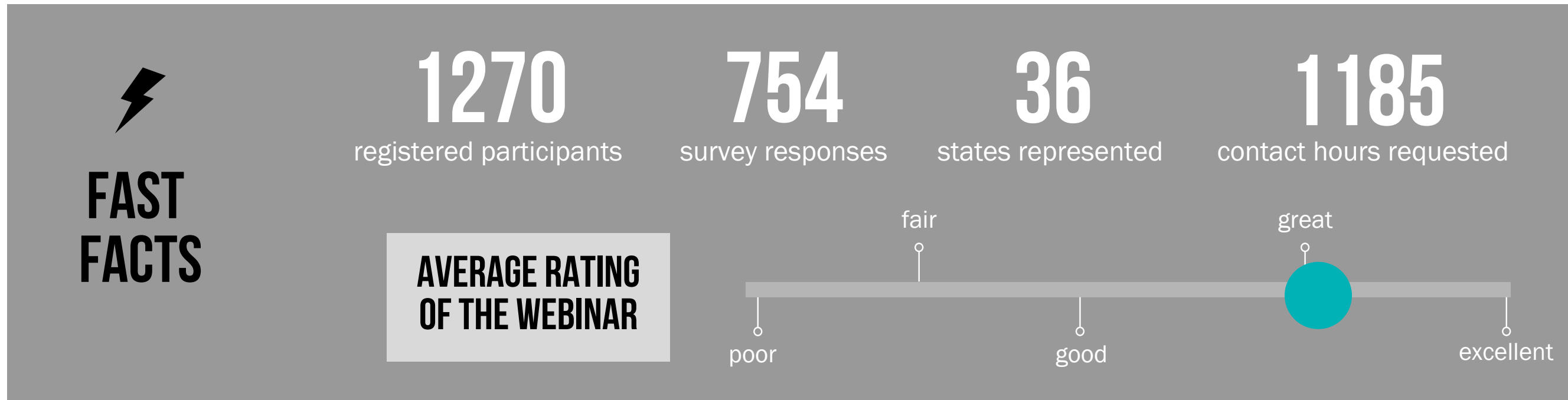

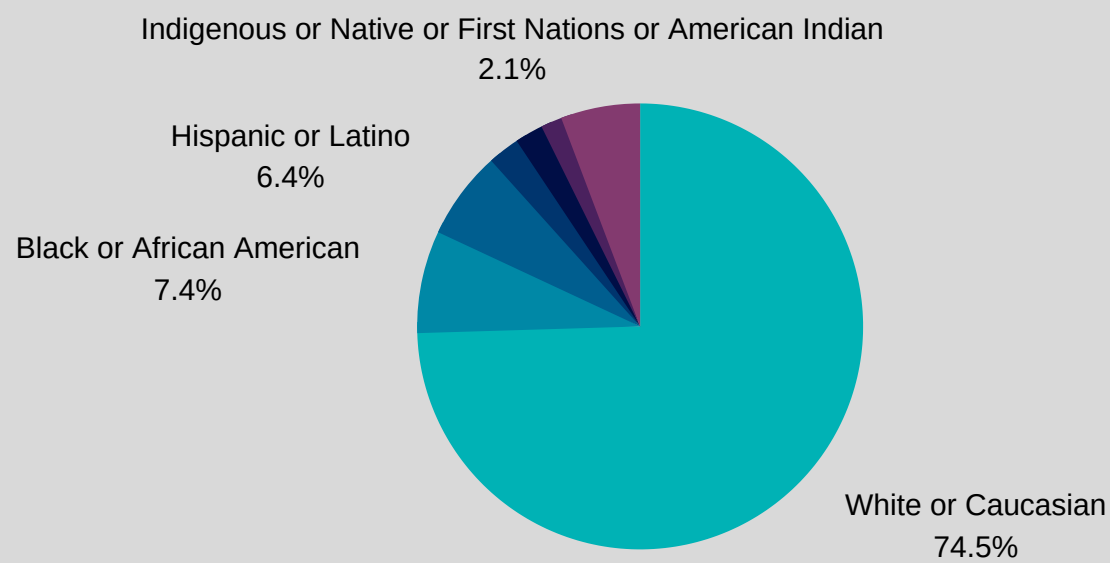
"I learned about the importance of having Indigenous trained lactation professionals and the power of water in these cultures."

"I realized that water is important for bodily functions but I also learned how important and spiritual that water is in Indigenous culture."

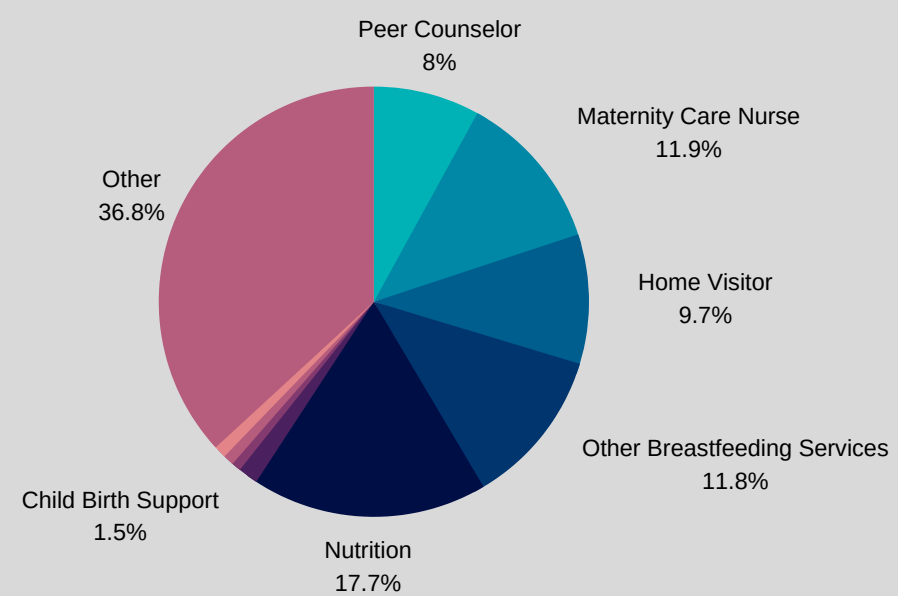

RACIAL/ETHNIC SELF-IDENTIFICATION



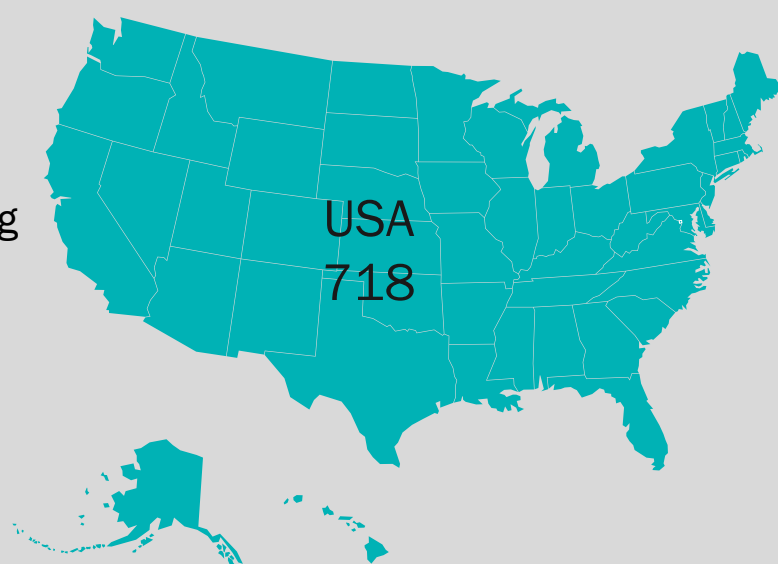
PRIMARY JOB FUNCTION
