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

INTRODUCTION

Milk Like Mine is a coalition that is dedicated to addressing disparities in their community, educating families, and empowering community in order to improve maternal and infant mortality throughout Battle Creek. They provide direct birthing and breastfeeding support to families, facilitate support groups and childbirth education classes, host monthly coalition meetings for networking, and work on community advocacy. Milk Like Mine focuses on providing skilled lactation support to families of color so that support can be offered by providers that reflect the families they serve.

Milk Like Mine is a trusted organization within the Battle Creek area and also work on community advocacy to address the larger more systemic issues of health disparities, specifically breastfeeding rates and infant mortality, through a justice lens in birth and breastfeeding with hospitals, employers, and community members. Their responsiveness to the community's needs is consistently grounded in creativity while developing the services offered and provided to the community. The evidence is clear that community-based support is the most effective. As trusted experts in their community, Milk Like Mine has been doing this work for 10 years and their expertise in this work is evident in all that they do.

SUCCESSES

Milk Like Mine is deeply committed to restoring power to families of color. They believe that reflecting the communities they serve is essential to providing skilled birth and breastfeeding support. This funding helped Milk Like Mine to provide direct birthing and breastfeeding services to Battle Creek families.



CONDUCTED 20 INDIVIDUAL BREASTFEEDING CONSULTS

Milk Like Mine staff provided lactation support to 20 families along with care plans, continued follow-up care and referrals.



HOSTED MONTHLY HOSPITAL BREASTFEEDING SUPPORT CLASSES

Due to COVID-19 restrictions and policies within the hospital, Bronson Battle Creek referred families to Milk Like Mine's Community Birthing & Breastfeeding Services Center for free and accessible breastfeeding support classes and groups outside of the hospital.



HELD 52 WEEKLY VIRTUAL BREASTFEEDING SUPPORT GROUPS

Milk Like Mine facilitated "Holding Space: Breastfeeding and Mental Health Support During A Pandemic" alongside Southeast Michigan IBCLCs of Color (SEMI). In order to increase access to mental health support during the pandemic, families gathered weekly in an interactive, virtual space with a facilitator (Rickeshia from Milk Like Mine), IBCLC, and therapist.







TEACH MONTHLY HIGH SCHOOL BREASTFEEDING SUPPORT CLASSES

Pregnant teens came to Milk Like Mine's Community Birthing & Breastfeeding Services Center for inperson lactation classes and support.



FUN FACT:

One of the teens from the high school actually got involved in supporting with Milk Like Mine's social media and other marketing strategies as a way to support the movement and give back thanks to the care she received.



SECURED MENTORSHIP TO COMPLETE PATHWAY 3 TOWARDS IBCLC CREDENTIAL AND COMPLETED 100 HOURS AS A MENTEE

This project supported Rickeshia with clinical hours needed for training and one-on-one clinical care with clients as part of her process toward becoming the first Black IBCLC in Battle Creek.



PROVIDED MONTHLY SISTAH 2 SISTAH SUPPORT GROUP MEETINGS

Milk Like Mine held 12 Sistah 2 Sistah support groups in-person and online via Zoom during this project.



ENGAGED 5 COMMUNITY PARTNERS FOR COLLABORATION

Milk Like Mine engaged with 5 community partners (Bronson Battle Creek, Grace Health, Calhoun County WIC, VA, doulas, midwives, OBs in private practice) to provide referrals and ensure continuity of care across systems.

SHE SAID THAT HER AND HER BABY WERE IN A MUCH HAPPIER SPACE."

CONVENED MONTHLY MILK LIKE MINE COALITION MEETINGS



SERVE AS A DOULA ALONGSIDE 3 FAMILIES OF COLOR

Milk Like Mine doulas provided full spectrum support for 3 families inclusive of childbirth education, breastfeeding education, building birth preference lists, visits at the home and at the Community Birthing & Breastfeeding Services Center, transportation to and from doctor appointments, postpartum care, mental health supports, referrals and community resources.
