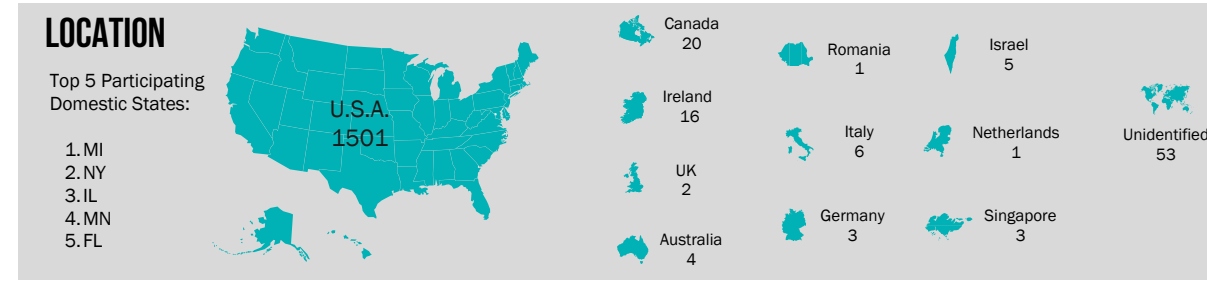
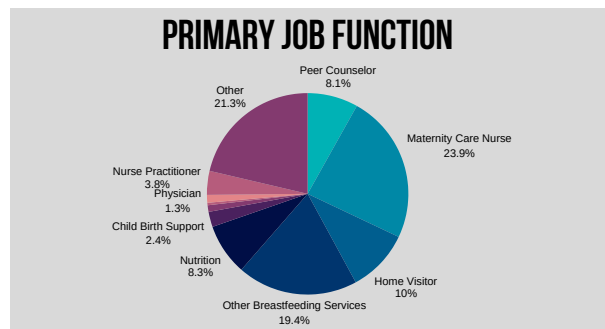
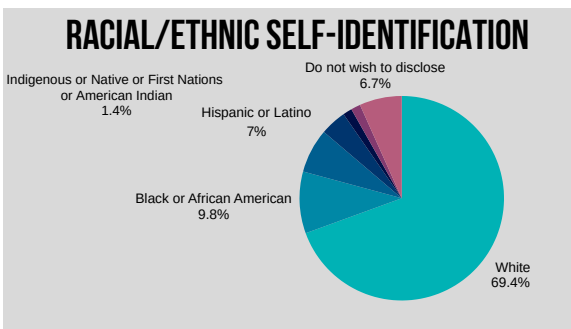

- "It was good to get perspective from all different sides of the spectrum. I felt like I got a good understanding of what restorative justice should and should not look like, especially within the body of maternal health and lactation care."

Don't just say you've changed a mascot name, product description, virtue signaling things that don't matter when what is being asked for is a sense of safety. Answer that action request over all of the frivolous things. And don't just make instant apologies to make yourself feel better. Actually take time to reflect on your words or actions to change them."
- "I enjoyed the realness, the accuracy, and real strategies and awareness that must be implemented to exact real change!"
- "I learned how important it is for restorative justice to listen to the individual or community you serve to find out what needs they have, what they want in order to avoid a solution that does nothing to address their needs."
