- Participate in annual training on credentialing body's continuing education requirements to ensure accurate and complete applications
- Participate in semi-annual planning meetings to determine topics, objectives, clinical relevance, and potential presenters
- Complete and submit continuing education applications in accordance with credentialing requirements for up to 16 webinars per year, ensuring they meet professional standards, per the National and Michigan Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics.
- Complete and submit all required follow-up reporting in alignment with credentialing requirements to the American Academy of Pediatrics.
- Complete a 6-month review with the Executive Director, Education Manager, and other applicable MIBFN Education Team staff
- Participate in periodic meetings with MIBFN Executive Director and/or MIBFN Education Team as needed and mutually
 agreed upon
- Provide MIBFN Community Education Manager and Executive Director with deliverables report with monthly invoice
